Academic Performance

CSM has always radiance in academic results in every year. Excellence in academics is the hallmark of any good institution and our last academic year class X and XII results proved without any doubt that our students made us proud.

Our X and XII students appeared for the CBSE Board Examination and the school result was excellent. 46 students scored distinction in Xth standard. The toppers in class X are Fathima E A, Raichal Jose and Mable T Paul. In XII we achieved 100% result, we got 20 distinction. The toppers in class XII are Safa Salamath in Science Stream and Riswana A K in XII Commerce stream.

New academic year started on June 10th 2019. Saplings were given to students on behalf of environment day which was to be conducted on June 5th.
